The Jackson County Medical Examiner (JCMEO) is requesting Neuropathology consultation services to be provided by Dr. Douglas Miller with the University of Missouri. As a National Association of Medical Examiners (NAME) accredited office, we are required to provide complete, reliable, reputable and credible forensic consultation services. These services include written reports which are sometimes incorporated into the official autopsy report or legal records of the case. Also, as required by NAME, consultants for this office require certification in select specialty fields. Dr. Douglas Miller is certified by the American Board of Pathology in Anatomic Pathology and Neuropathology.

JCMEO has requested neuropathology consultation services between 10 and 20 per year, depending on the case load. Our expenditure for these services has ranged from \$5000. up to \$15,000 within the last few years.
