Mike Sanders commented on the 2013 budget amendment. He also mentioned that it was Dan Tarwater's birthday.

Mike Sanders talked about the agreement with the City of Independence, Missouri regarding the animal shelter in Jackson County. He explained that the County Legislature had three pieces of legislation on the agenda today to discuss and adopt regarding the animal shelter.

Mike Sanders introduced Larry J. Schall, as Director of the Department of Public Works per County Executive Order #12-16.

He mentioned that the Administration will make a presentation to the County Legislature mid January 2013 regarding the Locally Preferred Alternatives. A representative from the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) and consultants will be present to answer questions. Crystal Williams and Theresa Garza Ruiz, County Legislators, have seen the presentation lasts approximately 2 hours.
