# IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION transferring \$131,240.00 within the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to fund professional service contracts recommended by the Executive Transition Team, and awarding a five (5) month contract for the creation of a prevention program team to assess future funding for drug prevention agencies and a four (4) month contract for the redesign of Drug Prevention Agency reporting and internal monitoring, both for use by the Jackson County COMBAT Commission, as sole source purchases, to Resource Development Institute (RDI) of Kansas City, MO, at a total cost to the County not to exceed \$50,000.00.

WHEREAS, section 1030.1, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when items to be purchased can be obtained from only one source and requires notification of and approval by the Legislature on such sole source purchases exceeding \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends a contract with RDI for the creation of a prevention program team to assess future funding for drug prevention agencies for use by the Jackson County COMBAT Commission at a cost to the County not to exceed \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing also recommends a contract with RDI for the redesign of Drug Prevention Agency reporting and internal monitoring for use by the Jackson County COMBAT Commission to Resource Development Institute (RDI) of Kansas City, MO, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has determined that RDI is the sole source for these services as RDI has worked with COMBAT in developing the overall evaluation plan and already has knowledge by working with COMBAT on the prevention RFP; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer is necessary to fund these professional service contracts, as well as other professional service contracts approved by the Executive Transition Team; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended said transfer; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer be and hereby is made:

## **CONSULTING AGREEMENT**

AN AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 12th day of 12th day o

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and RDI desire to enter into an Agreement whereby RDI will provide COMBAT Prevention Program Technical Assistance in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the County deems it to be in the best interest of the citizenry to support this program;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, the County and RDI respectively promise, covenant, and agree with each other as follows:

- 1. <u>Services To Be Provided</u>. RDI shall provide technical assistance in the redesign of the prevention program reporting, monitoring and evaluation process, as is more fully set out in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 2. <u>Terms of Payment</u>. The County agrees to pay an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 to RDI for the services specified in this Agreement, upon receipt of RDI's monthly invoices and documentation satisfactorily evidencing RDI's expenditure of these funds.
  - 3. Annual Report. RDI shall submit an annual report including invoices and



cancelled checks and other documentation as requested by the Director of Finance and Purchasing to show that the funds paid by the County were used for the purpose set forth in this Agreement. Said report shall be submitted no later than December 31, 2008, to the Director of Finance and Purchasing, 415 East 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. Failure to file said annual report shall disqualify RDI from future funding by the County.

- 4. <u>Audit</u>. The County further reserves the right to examine and audit, during reasonable office hours, the books and records of RDI pertaining to its finances and operations.
- 5. <u>Conflict of Interest</u>. RDI warrants that no officer or employee of the County, whether elected or appointed, shall in any manner whatsoever be interested in or receive any benefit from the profits or emoluments of this contract.
- 6. <u>Duration</u>. This Agreement shall be effective on September 1, 2008, and shall terminate on December 31, 2008.
- 7. <u>Severability</u>. If any covenant or other provision of this Agreement is invalid, or incapable of being enforced, by reasons of any rule of law or public policy, all other conditions and provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect and no covenant or provision shall be deemed dependent upon any other covenant or provision unless so expressed herein.
- 8. <u>Liability and Indemnification</u>. No party to this Agreement shall assume any liability for the acts of any other party to this Agreement, its officers, employees or agents and RDI shall indemnify, defend and hold the County harmless from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, costs (including reasonable attorney's fees directly related thereto)

including but not limited to violation of civil rights and/or bodily injury to or death of any person and for damage to or destruction of property if and to the extent caused by the negligence, willful misconduct or omissions of RDI, its officers, employees or agents during the performance of this Agreement.

Incorporation. This Agreement incorporates the entire understanding and 9. agreement of the parties.

#### CONSULTING AGREEMENT

AN AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this <u>12th</u> day of <u>November</u>, <u>2008</u> by and between **JACKSON COUNTY**, **MISSOURI**, a Constitutional Home Rule Charter County, hereinafter called "the County" and **RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE**, 601 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106, hereinafter called "RDI."

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and RDI desire to enter into an Agreement whereby RDI will assemble a site visit team and assess the readiness of agencies for evaluation in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the County deems it to be in the best interest of the citizenry to support this program;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, the County and RDI respectively promise, covenant, and agree with each other as follows:

- 1. <u>Services To Be Provided</u>. RDI shall assemble a site visit team to complete an evaluation assessment on each agency funded by COMBAT, as is more fully set out in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 2. <u>Terms of Payment</u>. The County agrees to pay an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 to RDI for the services specified in this Agreement, upon receipt of RDI's monthly invoices and documentation satisfactorily evidencing RDI's expenditure of these funds.
  - 3. Annual Report. RDI shall submit an annual report including invoices and
