WHEREAS, Hope House, New House, and Rose Brooks domestic violence shelters are not-for-profit organizations providing assistance to victims of domestic violence; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 20111, dated March 18, 2019, the Legislature did authorize the execution of cooperative agreements with these shelters in an aggregate amount of \$91,560.00; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County to provide assistance to the victims of domestic violence through funding of these shelters; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 8700., <u>Jackson County Code</u>, the Board of Domestic Violence Shelters was established to administer the distribution of fees collected pursuant to state statutes and the Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Board met June 12, 2019, and voted to recommend an allocation of the remaining \$61,041.00 of the projected 2019 budget revenues to be awarded as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreements and addenda thereto.

- 1. Melba Curls called the meeting to order at 9:19a.
- 2. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved, Motion by Jennifer Von Fintel, seconded by Teresa Chu.
- 3. New members were introduced and everyone in attendance introduced themselves
- 4. Old business: Board vacancy have continued to be a concern. With the appointments of Tonya and Jennifer all vacancies have been filled.

The three county domestic violence shelters each received an allocation of \$30.520 for the first half of 2019.

Continued discussion regarding changes to the 2020 applications was had. The result was a request to have each applicant submit a summary page with their application that includes the following:

- # of beds
- # of people served (children/adults)
- # of programs (children/adults & reference to learn more)
- Transitional Housing data
- Gross expenditures
- Grants (JACO, outside JACO)
- Demographics
- Average length of stay

5. New Business: The board reviewed the annual reports submitted by Hope House, Rose Brooks and New House. Discussion was had about the format and the possibility of having each present during the next round of applications to help clarify the information in the reports. Jennifer requested clarification from Hope House on what services are included in court advocacy.

Board discussed the new funding amounts and how to distribute those to the responding organizations. It was moved by Jennifer, seconded by Theresa with a unanimous vote to disburse the remaining 40% of funds evenly. \$61,041.00 will be allocated as follows:

\$ 20,347 to Rose Brooks

\$ 20.347 to New House

Jaime Masters reported that Requests for Proposals for the 2020 funding will be submitted to the three shelters on or by October, 2019. By November, 2019 the Board should be able to notify the shelters of the funding allocation for 2020.
