10 INTRODUCTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND ASSIGNMENT TO COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$10,000.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2021 Grant Fund in acceptance of funding provided by the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force for use by the Jackson County Drug Task Force for "Operation Nose to the Grindstone."

AN ORDINANCE establishing the "American Rescue Plan Fund" as a separate special revenue fund of the County, transferring \$4,998,014.00 within the 2021 CARES Act Fund, and accepting \$16,048,014.00 from the federal government, and appropriating \$4,998,014.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2021 American Rescue Plan Fund for the purpose of funding the Our Healthy KC Eastside program.
