









#### ERA 1 Survey

Surveys Sent to 2,478 Unique Emails




449 Unique Responses as of Feb. 3 (18%)




#### What happened after ERA assistance?

- 85.74% are stably housed today
- More than half think they'd need assistance to remain stably housed
  - 5.57% moved out
  - 8.69% got evicted or think they will soon




Where do you see yourself in the first 6 months of 2022?

- 45.88% will remain stably housed
- 40.98% said they'd need additional assistance to remain stably housed
  - 8.91% said they'd move out after lease is up
    - 4.23% said move out or eviction is likely




#### **How much is your monthly rent?**

- 38.76%: Less than \$750
  - 37.42% \$750-\$1,000
- 12.69% \$1,000-\$1,250
  - 11.14% \$1,250+



#### **Head of household's work situation?**

- 46.99%: Works full-time
- 21.6% Part-time or gig work
- 12.03% Disabled and not working
  - 12.47%: Not working




#### What's your biggest challenge?

- 8.46%: We're fine

- 16.04%: Rent is too high

- 19.82%: Utilities are too high

- 55.68%: Not bringing in enough money




Would you like to be a homeowner?

- 22.94%: Credit score is too low


- 9.58%: I'm better off renting

- 26.95%: It helped for a while, but I'm back in a tough time


