

Ralph A. Monaco, II is a long-time resident of Raytown, Missouri graduating from Raytown High School in 1974, where he had served as Student Body President. He graduated from Rockhurst College in 1978, *summa cum laude*, with degrees in history and political science. He earned his juris doctorate degree from UMKC Law School in 1981. He has been a practicing attorney for nearly forty-two years and is a Charter Member of the law firm of Monaco, Sanders, Racine, Powell & Reidy, L.C. As an attorney, Mr. Monaco has served as an adjunct professor at UMKC Law School, received the 2022 Preeminent AV Peer Review Award—the pinnacle of professional excellence from Martindale Hubbell, named Phi Alpha Delta (PAD) law fraternity's Alumni Member of the Year, where an annual award was established known as the "the Ralph A. Monaco Outstanding 3L Student Award" and produced numerous historic retrials in collaboration with UMKC Law School and the Jackson County Historical Society ("JCHS"),
