Three Organizational Focus Areas for Addressing Trauma

- Individual Level: Desired Outcome-strengthen families: full wrap-around service starting with Mental health, Employment, Housing etc
- Community Level: Desired Outcome- Develop shared language, cognitive restructuring, community education, connectivity
- Historical: Desired Outcome- Cultural Immersion, policy change, systems change

Community Wellness


- Reducing barriers to mental health and increased outreach and case management through professional staffing of Community Health and Intervention Specialist and Family Support Specialist.
- Quarterly conferences on trauma and violence
- Weekly visits to area schools to assess well-being of youth and families

- quarterly meetings with legislators on community change levers for mental health and employment equity
- Bi-annual meetings with law enforcement, political leaders, businesses on gun violence
- Hold bi-annual immersion experiences
