






River Market Off-Leash Area for Dogs Executive Summary

The River Market Community Improvement District (RMCID) and the River Market Community Association, both non-profit organizations comprised of property owners, business owners and residents, are advocating for the creation of a fenced, Off-Leash Area (OLA) in the River Market.



Presently, residents of the River Market and Columbus Park have few options in the area when it comes to places to safely and respectfully exercise their dogs. In many cases, dog owners let their dogs run off leash despite City ordinances require dogs to be on a leash at all time unless in a fenced in enclosure or building.

The River Market OLA, located at 5th and Locust Streets, will provide a place where people and their well-behaved dogs can socialize and exercise in a clean, safe environment, without endangering or disturbing people, property or wildlife. The RMCID will manage and maintain the OLA which will be on property leased from MoDOT.

The creation of an OLA will foster an increased sense of community by encouraging social interaction among citizens within the area, while reducing encounters with citizens who are apprehensive of off-leash dogs in other public parks.



Per your request, I am forwarding an updated scope of services for the remainder of the 2015 assessment and beginning of the 2017 assessment cycle. I've reviewed ongoing projects and anticipated upcoming projects that are dependent upon John Ebert's Scope of Work for future services. Specifically, the importance of a true and comprehensive parcel inventory for Jackson County became painfully evident by the end of the 2015 cycle. My suggestions for the completion of this task have been passed along to Mr. Ebert for consideration in his 2017 reassessment plan. Otherwise, all tasks have been included in one of three categories: Data collection, analysis and audit, valuation services and application.

All COV work for the final quarter of 2014 and the first half of 2015 has been estimated in the Data Collection category. It should be noted that the plan for appraiser qualification and data entry of COVs, as described by Mr. BurroughsScanlon, is a good one. However, the process has yet to be incorporated into the appraiser's routine and the work absolutely *must* be completed.
