Without this funding, these high risk youth would not be monitored for compliance to the court's requirements. This program has been shown to be effective in reducing recidivism. This program has been funded by COMBAT for at least the past seven years, because its support meets the mission and goal of COMBAT toward the reduction of violent crime within Jackson County by stopping adolescents from progressing further down the path of crime. This is a considerable cost savings to the County.
