REQUEST SUMMARY	The Road and Bridge Maintenance Division of Public Works requests the transfer of funds within the existing Special Road and Bridge Fund to accommodate two depleted account codes.						
	During the annual Road Program, several unanticipated road projects were encountered that required the use of hot mix asphalt. This need reduced the amount of funds available for normal day to day activities requiring asphalt. In order to complete the necessary repairs through the end of the year, we are requesting funds be transferred to restore the ability to maintain the County's asphalt roads.						
	In addition, due to the number of inclement weather events that the Road and Bridge Division has endured over the current calendar year, current quantities of sand inventory have been lowered beyond levels of confidence. It is anticipated that in order to properly operate inclement weather activities this winter additional funds will be necessary to restore stockpiles of sand.
