5476 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$142,000.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2020 CARES Act Fund to reimburse the Cities of Lone Jack and Sugar Creek, Missouri, for public safety regular salaries and overtime expenses and other necessary costs in connection with the fight against the ongoing Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic and authorizing the County Executive to execute addenda to the existing Intergovernmental Agreements with the Cities of Lone Jack and Sugar Creek, Missouri, at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$142,000.00.
