Ordinance 5539, adopted on August 30, 2021, awarded the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners (KCPD) an additional \$78,269. It's initial funds were allocated by the Legislature adoption of the 2021 Budget, Ordinance 5461, Flr. Amendment, December 14, 2020.

The KCPD, operating under the supervision of the Board of Police Commissioners, is the principal law enforcement agency serving Kansas City, Missouri. With its work in the prevention and investigation of crimes, and with its anti-violence programs, it assists in carrying out COMBAT's mission to assist in creating strong and safe communities, free from the dangers of illegal drugs and violent crime.
