Refunding of the Series 2014 Special Obligation Refunding Bonds (Harry S. Truman Sports Complex) and extend the contract with Stifel, Nicolaus & Co, Inc, of Kansas City, MO, for municipal financial advisory services through September 11, 2022.

Request Summary

Resolution 20105, dated March 11, 2019 awarded a twelve-month term and supply contract, with two twelve-month options to extend, for the furnishing of financial advisory services for use by the County to George K. Baum under terms and conditions of RFQ 66-18.

Resolution 20500, dated September 21, 2020 authorized an addendum to the Fiduciary Engagement Agreement with Stifel, Nicolaus & Co, Inc, of Kansas City, MO. The addendum was effective September 28, 2020 and shall remain in effect until September 11, 2021; unless further extended by the parties until September 11, 2022.

In September of 2021 the Director of Finance and Purchasing extended the contract for a renewal term of less than the year provided of September 11, 2022. The contract is now set to expire December 31, 2021.

The forty-seventh regular meeting of the Jackson County Legislature, Monday, December 6, 2021, included a presentation by Michael Short & Matt Webster (Stifel); Douglas Coe (Moody Reid) – Co-Financial Advisors to the County regarding the refunding opportunity of the Series 2014 Special Obligation Refunding Bonds (Harry S. Truman Sports Complex Project). The presentation of the refunding opportunity included a projected net savings of \$13 million upfront cash payment which would be limited to capital improvements at the Truman Sports Complex.

The County Legislature expresses support that Jackson County move forward with the opportunity for the Refunding of the Series 2014 Special Obligation Refunding Bonds (Harry S. Truman Sports Complex Project).

It is the desire that the existing contract with Stifel, Nicolaus & Co, Inc be extended to September 11, 2022 pursuant to the terms allowed under Resolution 20105 and Resolution 20500 in order to carry out this transaction which is expected to close at the end of January or February 2022.

Pursuant to terms of the existing contract with Stifel, Nicolaus & Co, Inc, all fees associated with transactions will be paid at the completion of the sale of Bonds, Notes, or other securities issued on behalf of the County.

Legislator Galvin, Legislator Tarwater, and Legislator Anderson will sponsor.
