## Introduction

Approval of Federal Lands Access Program "Program Agreement" for pavement repair/overlay at Blue Springs Lake

## Request Summary

Jackson County has been selected to participate in a reimbursement grant under the Federal Lands Access Program, (FLAP), to be used for repair/overlay of 2.5 miles of roadway and parking areas at Blue Springs Lake. We are requesting an Ordinance authorizing the County Executive to execute the attached Program Agreement between the Federal Highway Administration – Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division, Missouri Department of Transportation and Jackson County. It outlines the roles, responsibilities and obligations of each party under the Agreement. The total project funding will be \$950,000.00; (\$760,000.00 federal and \$190,000.00 Local). A formal bid for construction is anticipated to be let in Fall/Winter of 2022.

We further request that \$760,000.00 be appropriated from the 2022 Grant Fund to cover the upfront cost of the Federal participation amount. The Parks Department has \$190,000.00 appropriated in the 2022 operating budget to cover the Local portion.

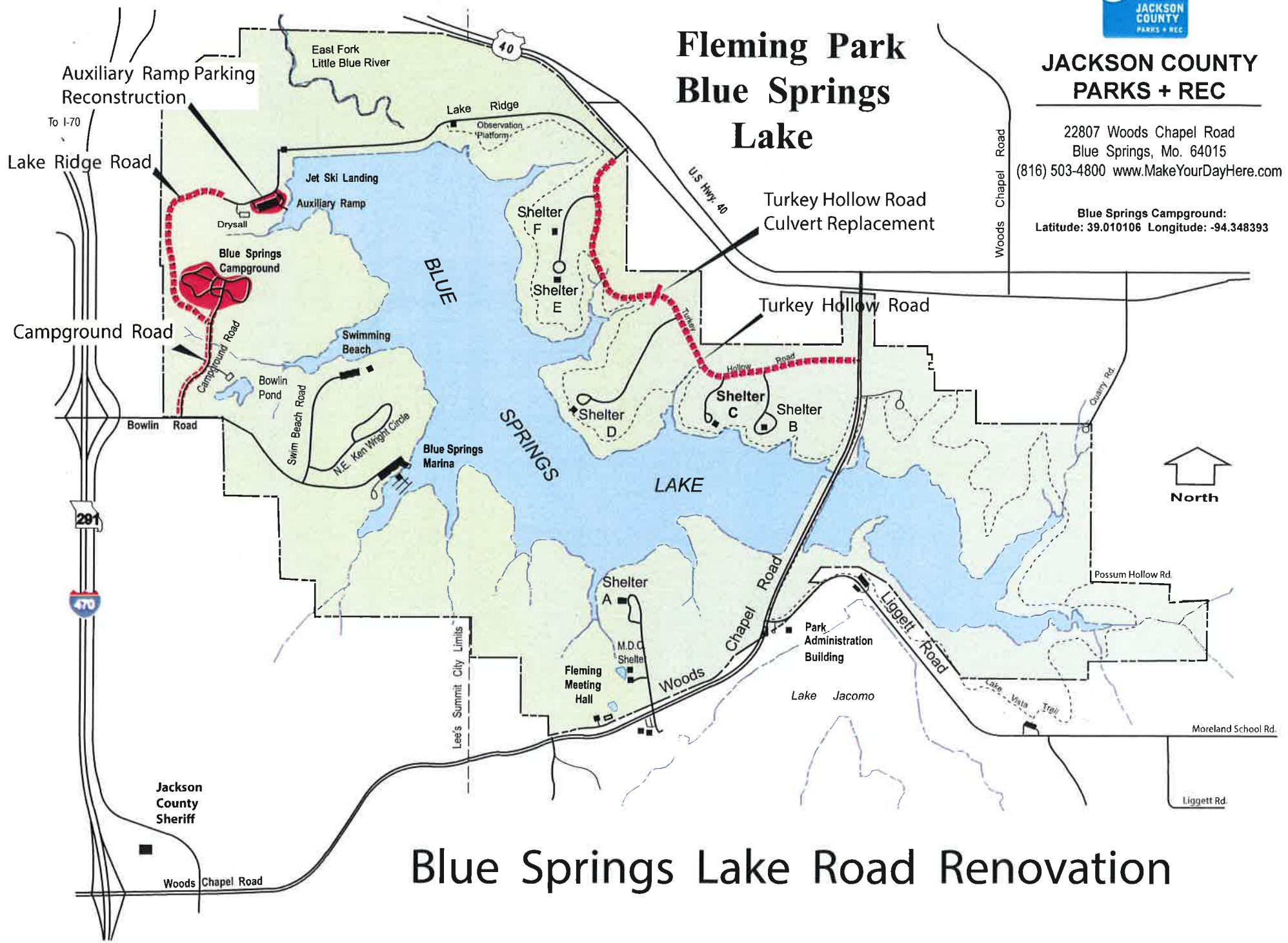
