#### Project/Title:

Awarding a Twenty-Four Month Term and Supply Contract with Two Twelve-Month Options to Extend for the furnishing of Janitorial Supplies for Various Departments to RJ Kool, dba Controlled Environmental Products, of North Kansas City, MO under the Terms and Conditions of Invitation to Bid No. 23-017.

### **Request Summary**

Various Jackson County Departments require a Term and Supply Contract for the furnishing of Janitorial Supplies. The Purchasing Department issued Invitation to Bid No. 23-017 in response to those requirements. A total of 65 notifications were distributed, 67 vendors downloaded the Bid Documents, and eight responses were received, with two responses being rejected due to not completing mandatory submissions.

Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Purchasing Department recommends the award of a Twenty-Four Month Term and Supply Contract with Two Twelve-Month Options to Extend, for the furnishing of Janitorial Supplies to RJ Kool, dba Controlled Environmental Products, of North Kansas City, MO. The anticipated spend for this contract is \$300,000. This award is made on an "As Needed" basis and does not obligate the County to pay any specific amount.


