Premier Membership in the amount of \$15,000 to the National WWI Museum and Memorial to support free admission to the Museum and the associated events for veterans and active-duty military members during the 2023 Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day Celebration, and half-price admission for everyone else.

Request Summary

The Administration recommends a Premier Membership which will support free admission for veterans and active-duty military members and half-price admission for everyone else to the Museum and the associated events at the National WWI Museum and Memorial over Memorial Day Weekend, Friday May 26 to Monday, May 29, 2023, and Veterans Day, Saturday, November 11, 2023. The Museum and Memorial embraces the importance Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies and programs have in the community. With the Administration and Legislature's membership support this will be the second year Jackson County has provided funding for free admission for veterans and active duty military personnel and half-price for all other attendees for both Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day. Family friendly activities and exhibits, musical performances and speeches from local and national dignitaries are scheduled through out the day for both Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day. The Jackson County Executive and Legislature will be mentioned in all news releases related to the Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day Celebration as well as recognition in the Museum and Memorial's Annual Report and on the Donor Wall. The Jackson County logo will be featured on the ceremonial programs, webpages, and signage. The Premier Membership is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County. It is recommended that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby authorized to issue a check to the National WWI Museum and Memorial, in the amount of \$15,000.00, for a Museum Premier Membership which will support the 2023 Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day activities.

Jackson County Executive and Legislature 2023 Premier Membership Proposal: Free Admission for Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day Activities

The National WWI Museum and Memorial proposes a \$15,000 Museum Premier Membership which will support free admission to the Museum and the associated events for veterans and active-duty military members during our 2023 Memorial Day and Veterans Day Celebrations, and half-price admission for everyone else.

Memorial Day Weekend Friday 26 May 2023 – Monday 29 May 2023

Memorial Day Ceremony: 10:00 am
Bell Tolling Ceremony 12:00 pm
Walk of Honor Ceremony 2:00 pm

Veterans Day Celebration: Saturday 11 November 2023

Veterans Day Ceremony: 10:00 am

The Museum and Memorial embraces the importance our Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies and programs have in our community, for the veterans; active military; and their families, and people across the United States and around the world. We believe it is not just our duty but our honor to provide the highest quality ceremonies for the public to attend, both in-person and virtually.

Dan Howe, a recent ceremony attendee said, "I just wanted to say thank you for everything. The ceremony was wonderful and the brick placement was next to perfect. My father loved it and he was very proud to have a permanent brick at such a great memorial facility."

Expected 2023 Attendance and Format:

Although the number of COVID-19 cases is declining and more and more people are receiving vaccinations, our 2023 Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies will be similar to our 2022 ceremonies. We will follow Jackson County and the City of Kansas City mandates on mask-wearing, social distancing, and other health protocols. We do not anticipate changes to what is currently in place. We will live-stream both ceremonies for people to watch from anywhere across the globe.

With the increasing number of vaccinated people, we expect the 2023 numbers to be closer to our 2019 attendance, rather than the more-modest 2020 attendance.

- In 2019, we had 4,845 visitors for all the events, including 2,400 people attending the Memorial Day Ceremony, 400 people attending the Memorial Day Bell Tolling Ceremony, 255 people attending the Memorial Day Walk of Honor Ceremony, 265 people attending the Veterans Day Ceremony, and 225 people attending the Walk of Honor Ceremony.
- In 2020, we were closed for Memorial Day Weekend and had 3,024 visitors for all the events, including 1,975 for the Veterans Day Ceremony, 225 people for the Walk of Honor ceremony, 500 people for the Legacy Jump, 149 people for the Cars4Heroes event, and 175 people attending the Kansas City Symphony quintet performance.



Speakers and Activities:

Though our 2023 programs and activities have not yet been finalized, we expect they will be similar to what we have done in the past. Both the Memorial Day and Veterans Day Ceremonies will include an honor guard, remarks from selected local and national dignitaries, a keynote speaker, and musical performances. We will also conduct family-friendly activities during the celebration. Some of our previous activities have included a Vietnam-era helicopter, Hands-on-History/Living History, and special research stations.

- The Jackson County Executive and Legislature will be mentioned in all Museum and Memorial new releases related to the Memorial Day Weekend and Veterans Day celebration;
- Recognition in Museum and Memorial's Annual Report and on the Donor Wall.

Thanks to the Jackson County Executive and Legislature's support. For the past seven years, the Museum and Memorial has provided free admission to veterans and active military and half-price admission for everyone else.
