**SUBJECT:** Surplus Vehicles

Ms. Casamento,

Thank you again for meeting with us last week. Attached you will find the list of vehicles we need to surplus. As we discussed, these vehicles are in various states of wear. Some are wrecked, others have been scavenged for parts, and still others are completely worn out. All are in such a state that they are worth more as scrap metal than trying to auction off.

Also, as we discussed, these vehicles were not titled in the past with the state. Making their sale extremely difficult at best. Pursuant to RSMO 301.227 paragraph 9, vehicles that are inoperable and at least ten model years old may be sold to a scrap metal operator without a title or certificate of origin. All the vehicles listed are or will be ten model years old within a few weeks and inoperable.

With your department's assistance, I would like to request legislative action to declare these vehicles surplus and have them scrapped by a local scrap operator. Any proceeds from the scrap operator will go to offset the costs of towing the vehicles and any excess deposited with the finance department.
