Upon verification of the above participation activities, the Missouri Safety Center/UCM will process the reimbursement for costs up to the maximum total amount.

Any such changes made to this agreement require the written approval of each party's Authorized Official.
- 428) Each party shall be responsible for its negligent acts or omissions and the negligent acts or omissions of its employees, officers, or directors, to the extent allowed by law.
- 429) Either party may terminate this agreement with thirty days written notice to the appropriate party's Administrative Contact, as shown in Attachment 3. If applicable, University shall pay Collaborator for termination costs as allowable under OMB Circular A-87, OMB Circular A-21, OMB Circular A-122, or the Federal Acquisition Regulation, whichever applies.
