Sub: Cooperative Agreement for Trail Improvements in the Little Blue Trace Park

The Jackson County Parks & Recreation Department and the Kansas City Public Works Department wish to enter into a Cooperative Agreement allowing the City and County to jointly construct sections of trail on County property within the Little Blue Trace Park. Staffs from both agencies have been working to plan trail extensions, in phases, as funding from the City becomes available.

Background:

- O Jackson County presently owns and holds for public use certain lands within the City limits of the City of Kansas City in connection with County's Little Blue Trace Park lying between Lee's Summit Road on the north and Longview Lake on the south.
- Kansas City having the means available, or potentially available, to it to improve said lands with a multipurpose trail, desires to make such improvements with County's permission;
- Kansas City is completing construction plans for an initial one mile extension of the Little Blue Trace Trail from Lee's Summit Road.
- Kansas City is completing construction plans for the Little Blue Trace Trail from Longview Lake Dam to I-470.
- Kansas City and County would like to construct phases of the Little Blue Trace Trail upon the availability of funds.
- The purposes of this Agreement is to outline the roles and responsibilities of both the City and County for the long-range implementation of the Little Blue Trace Trail whereby City and County can work cooperatively to complete the Trail;
- Kansas City has approved the Agreement by Ordinance No. 110417.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE LITTLE BLUE TRACE PARK

Res. 17650

This Cooperative Agreement for construction road improvements is made by and between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", and Jackson County, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY".

Recitals
