Century Link, GTL and Securus were the three bidders on this RFP. The bids were thoroughly reviewed by Laura Scott, Jackie Robinson and Praeses staffs, who act as the inmate phone consultant service for the Department of Corrections. Management staff and the Director reviewed all of the summary data produced by the detailed readings. After this review, vendors were rated in the first three areas: 1) Compliance with RFP Requirements; 2) System Proposed; and 3) References and Qualifications. When this part of the evaluation was complete, the fourth category, Pricing, was reviewed, summarized, discussed and rated. In addition to this activity, the GTL software system was demonstrated during the evaluation of the RFP. The Securus system is currently in use and well known, and the Century Link system had previously been demonstrated at the facility. Compliance with RFP Requirements: Century Link was rated highest in this area with fewer exceptions and/or items needing clarification. System Proposed: All software systems appear to be comparable in regards to platform types and equipment, user interface/remote access, monitoring and recording, investigative features, pin application, interfacing with BARIS, pre-pay programs and other features and options. Century Link was rated higher in this area for two reasons: 1) The capacity to provide a unique integration with the Keefe commissary system that currently controls the inmate account fund, and 2) Agreeing to comply with the escheatment process according to the Missouri Unclaimed Property Act. Both GTL (at 90 days) and Securus (at 120 days) absorb any outstanding revenue, References and Qualifications: Two of the listed references were contacted for each vendor. All feedback from external references was positive in nature. Century Link scored highest in this area. External references were positive and the company is local, located in Overland Park, KS. This is likely to enhance both communication and service. **Pricing:** Century Link scored highest in the pricing category, and Management staff agree that we like the proposed base cost of \$2.05 across all types of calling (except International) with no additional per minute fees. This cost also remains lower than several comparable Missouri facilities: St. Charles County charges \$8 for a 15 minute Jefferson County charges \$10.95 for a 15 minute collect call, and Missouri Department of Corrections charges \$2.50 for a 15 minute collect call. In addition, a base cost across all calling types is easy for both staff and inmates to remember. There will be fewer questions/issues related to minute by minute fees. Century Link was selected as the lowest and best bidder. Please see evaluation scores, which were averaged across all ratings.
