REQUEST SUMMARY	Union Pacific Railroad and MoDOT have proposed closing the crossing of Old Lexington Road, just east of Odonnell road, as a part of their program to reduce hazardous railroad crossings. The Public Works Department is in agreement with the closing, and has completed the process of vacating the appropriate section of Old Lexington Road. See Ordinance No. 4379. The agreement provides for the County to close the road and build a cul-de-sac with appropriate signage, acquire the right of way for the cul-de-sac, obtain hearing waivers from the adjacent property owners, make payments to the two property owners, and control traffic while work is underway to accomplish the crossing closure. In return the Union Pacific RR and MoDot will do all work on the RR right of way to accomplish the RR crossing closure, and pay to the County the sum of \$187,000.00, part to pay property owners for loss of access, and part to pay for the work to close the road. We hereby request that a resolution be prepared authorizing the County Executive to execute the attached supplemental agreement with Union Pacific and Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission.
