Subject: COMBAT Request for Legislative Action

COMBAT is initiating an RLA for the authorization to enter into a cooperative agreement with Connections to Success for the funding for the Jackson County Constructing Futures IV Project for the 2013 fiscal year. This has been a multi-year project supported by Jackson County and COMBAT. The total budget for the Jackson County Constructing Futures IV Project is anticipated to be \$97,450 of which \$20,000 will come from Anti-Drug Sales Tax Funds budgeted for 2013 and \$12,370 from the Anti-Drug Sales Tax Funds remaining from a 2012 Connections to Success contract. The remaining funds for this project will come from the Housing Services Commission under separate legislation and additional funding procured by Connections to Success.

These funds will continue to provide job training for Jackson County citizens who are recovering drug offenders and/or formerly incarcerated and/or unskilled and underemployed individuals, to assist their learning in the construction trades by rehabilitating houses located throughout Jackson County, Missouri. The houses can then be occupied by a family who has recently struggled with homelessness. The Jackson County Constructing Futures IV Project has identified two homes in the Ivanhoe Neighborhood located at 3750 Highland and at 1716 East 35<sup>th</sup> Street.
