ArtsKC – Regional Arts Council intends to pursue the creation of the first-ever Regional Cultural Plan for the greater Kansas City metropolitan area. In a Town Hall Meeting last fall, the Arts Council was acknowledged as the best organization to take the lead in the planning process. Since then, the Arts Council has continued to drive the planning agenda forward and is ready to seek the funds required to take the process to a new level. A Regional Cultural Plan will establish a path toward deeper engagement with the community, making the arts more purposeful, rewarding, and meaningful for our agencies and our community.

The planning process incorporates the results of two national research studies that were completed in 2012: the Local Arts Index, and Arts and Economic Prosperity IV, both conducted locally by the Arts Council in partnership with Americans for the Arts. Each of the five counties in the Kansas City metropolitan region has its own Local Arts Index report, the most complete and detailed study of the arts ecology ever conducted in the five counties to date. Our access to recent data of this quality and substance is an essential building block in the planning process and one of the reasons that makes a cultural planning process an imperative at this time. To ensure a successful planning process, the Arts Council has conducted the following activities:

1) presenting and discussing the data from the Local Arts Index and the economic impact study in community forums throughout the metropolitan area; 2) meetings with key stakeholders and strategic partners to secure support and participation in the planning process; 3) acquire the expertise of a national consultant in the cultural planning process.

Our next steps will be to1) research and review other community's cultural plans, and 2) develop a governance structure for the process. We envision the creation of a steering committee composed of members from each of the five counties in the metropolitan core of the Kansas City region. Each county will be charged with identifying key leaders residing in that county that represent civic, business, tourism, education, philanthropic, arts (both for-profit and non-profit) and government interests. The steering committee will work in collaboration with our consultant to conduct a visioning process that will define a specific focus or direction for the development of the Regional Cultural Plan based on four priority areas. 1) Arts Education 2) Communication 3) Collaboration/Use of Cultural facilities and 4) Arts as Economic development tool – Creative Placemaking .The community forums and focus groups will be organized by varying criteria, such as geographic location, profession, and type and level of interest. With a clear assessment of cultural assets in the region and a thorough inventory of community needs, ideas, and priorities, we will analyze the information and look for overlap and emerging themes.
