

FIRST ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT, by and between JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and CONNECTIONS TO SUCCESS. 3120 Troost Avenue, Kansas City, MO 64109, a Missouri not-for-profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Organization," is made and entered into this 🍪 day of __, 2014.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18365, dated January 13, 2014, the County and Organization did enter into a Cooperative Agreement whereby Organization agreed to serve as manager for the 2014 Jackson County Constructing Futures Program, at a cost to the County in the amount of \$25,000.00, of which \$12,000.00 was designated to complete the 2013 Constructing Futures Program and \$13,000.00 was designated for the 2014 Program; and,

WHEREAS, this project is a collaboration between the Jackson County Housing Resources Commission and the COMBAT Administration; and,

WHEREAS, the Housing Resources Commission and the Drug Commission recommend this First Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement for the 2014 Constructing Futures Program, at an additional cost to the County in the amount of \$65,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4622, dated May 19, 2014, the County Legislature has authorized the County Executive to enter into this Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, County and Organization do hereby additionally agree as follow:

- 1. Except as hereinafter specifically modified, all of the terms of the prior Agreement between the parties dated March 14, 2014, including the Exhibit A, <u>Program Description</u>, and Exhibit B, <u>Work Authorization Affidavit</u>, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms and conditions thereof are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Legal Counsel shall be increased by the amount of \$65,000.00, for a maximum total of \$90,000.00, of which \$78,000.00 is designated for the 2014 Constructing Futures program, in accordance with the Program Budget attached hereto as Exhibit C.
- 3. The County agrees to pay Organization one-quarter of its budget for the 2014 Program, or \$19,500.00 upon execution of this Agreement. The remaining funds shall be paid monthly upon receipt of Organization's invoices and documentation submitted satisfactorily evidencing Organization's expenditure of the funds, pursuant to Exhibit C.
- 4. This Addendum to Agreement shall be effective as of January 1, 2014, and shall extend, with the original Agreement, through December 31, 2014.
- 5. This Addendum, together with the Agreement dated March 14, 2014, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
