WHEREAS, Consultant and County entered into a Consulting Agreement dated May 5, 2011, whereunder Consultant agreed to provide consulting services and assistance to the County in analyzing viable options for compliance with the FCC conversion mandate, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$38,250.00; and,

WHEREAS, subsequent addenda authorized by the Legislature have extended the Agreement with Tusa through December 31, 2014, and expanded the Scope of Work to include assistance with the implementation of an updated radio system at the new Sheriff's Headquarters; and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the Agreement and expand the scope to improve service coverage in the southern portions of the County; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18819, dated May 4, 2015, the County Legislature has authorized this Fifth Addendum to the Consulting Agreement with Consultant to provide these additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Consultant respectively agree with each other as follows:



- 1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Consulting Agreement, dated May 16, 2011, the First Addendum dated February 29, 2012, the Second Addendum dated May 10, 2013, the Third Addendum dated November 8, 2013, and the Fourth Addendum dated March 26, 2014, between Consultant and County shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2. This Fifth Addendum shall be effective January 1, 2015 and shall extend until December 31, 2015.
- 3. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Consultant shall be increased by the amount of \$4,860.00, for a maximum total of \$162,990.00, payable pursuant to the attached Exhibit A.
- 4. The Scope of Services shall be amended to include assistance with improved local portable coverage, as is more fully set out in the project change order attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
- 5. This Fifth Addendum, together with the Consulting Agreement dated May 16, 2011, the First Addendum dated February 29, 2012, the Second Addendum, dated May 10, 2013, the Third Addendum dated November 8, 2013, and the Fourth Addendum dated March 26, 2014, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
