The second side letter agreement endorses the creation of new job classifications (APA I, APAII and APAIII) and establishing minimum and maximum pay ranges under the current Collective Bargaining Agreement. This is in an effort to align duties and responsibilities, create promotion opportunities and become competitive with the surrounding market.
