BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Hickman Mills Prevention Coalition for the furnishing of a violent crime prevention program, in the amount of \$59,000.00, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.
