Subject: Connections Maintenance Agreement

COMBAT is preparing to renew the software maintenance agreement with First Call for the substance abuse treatment data tool, COMBAT ~ Connections (also known as Community Care Link). COMBAT ~ Connections is a web-based application where COMBAT-funded substance abuse treatment programs can enter data elements related to the treatment services they are receiving which can then be used for outcomes measures.

The COMBAT ~ Connections project has been a project that has been developed and implemented over the past few years as identified below:

Res. #16711 September 29, 2008 Res. #17234 April 19, 2010 Res. #17618 June 27, 2011 Res. #18015 November 5, 2012

The above referenced resolutions identified that the Director of Finance and Purchasing had determined that First Call was a sole source because of its unique familiarity with the program and the County's needs. Frist Call has worked closely with COMBAT and our substance abuse treatment providers to develop, implement, and maintain the application to provide data elements and data measures to determine the effectiveness of COMBAT funding.

We are looking to renew the maintenance agreement for this application which is for a one-year period and has three annual renewal options. The cost will be \$1500.00 annually for each COMBAT funded Treatment agency; the current installment of \$18,000 for the remainder of 2016 is in the COMBAT budget

Dear Stacey:

This letter confirms that the COMBAT Connections Software Maintenance and Support Fee for Jackson County (COUNTY) use of Community CareLink is \$39,000, payable in two installments annually, six months apart. Twelve (12) months of maintenance commencing upon the effective date shall be included. The Software Maintenance and Support Agreement shall have three (3) one-year renewal options.

The Software Maintenance and Support Fee is calculated based on the number of concurrent agencies. FIRST CALL and the COUNTY agree that \$39,000 covers a maximum of 26 COMBAT funded treatment agencies.

Once the COUNTY exceeds 26 concurrent agencies, each additional agency will increase the annual Software Maintenance and Support Fee by \$1,500.00.
