A Program of Grandparents Against Gun Violence

The Heartland Coalition Against Gun Violence is a group of organizations initially gathered to host a community forum in October, 2014. The topic was Gun Violence – Finding Common Ground. Taking Action. There were 28 co-sponsors and 140 attendees. On October, 2015 we sponsored a second Forum: Gun Violence. A Public Health Issue. There were 36 co-sponsors and 166 attendees
