REQUEST SUMMARY	The Jackson County Legislature approved funding in the amount of \$2,721,000.00 from the category of COMBAT Treatment funding earlier this year. This left a remainder of \$271,126.00 in the Treatment account. A Special Treatment Request for Proposals was released on July 28, 2016. Eleven (11) responses were received by the due date of August 23, 2016. They were scored for merit by independent experts in the field of Substance Abuse Treatment. The recommendations were based on the highest scores received and availability of funds. Exhibit A indicates the outside agencies, the purpose for the proposed services and the funding level recommendations. These recommendations were reviewed and approved by the Jackson County Drug Commission on September 7, 2016.
