The Parks Department has received a "Concurrence In Award" letter from the Missouri Department of Transportation that Orr Wyatt Streetscapes provided the lowest and best bid. The Jackson County Compliance Review Office has stated that Orr Wyatt Streetscapes is in compliance. Funding for this project was appropriated previously by Ordinance 4827 on February 29, 2016. 
