Background: The Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted services for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention and other anti-drug and anti-violence initiatives in the community. Previous legislation was authorized for this program. This agency has not utilized the total allocation for 2016 funding. This action allows them to extend the 2016 contract so funds can be utilized on providing and implementing programs that focus on academics, leadership, critical thinking and mentoring for African American males between 12-18 years of age, as part of the targeted neighborhood initiative that began in July 2016.
