MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, FIRST AMENDMENT FOR RENEWAL

On December 31, 2014, an Agreement was executed between The Research Foundation of the City University of New York c/o John Jay College of Criminal Justice, the Center for Crime Prevention and Control ("Research Team"), Jackson County, Missouri (Jackson County), City of Kansas City, Missouri (KCMO), and Board of Police Commissioners, as the governing body of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department (KCPD), referred to collectively herein as "Partners," for the period of 18 months beginning July 12, 2014 and ending December 31, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Partners agree to amend the Agreement terms and conditions only as follows, with all other terms and conditions remaining unchanged:

Preamble: The Preamble is amended to reflect the period of January 1, 2016 through April 15, 2017.

Section 2, National Network Project Assistance Goals: Section 2 is amended to reflect the proposal set forth in the Research Team's "Period Two Proposal" attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.

Section 3, Project Cost and Deliverables: Section 3 is amended to reflect the sum total of \$15,000.00 to be paid by Jackson County and \$10,000.00 to be paid by KCMO to Research Team for work performed pursuant to the Agreement during the time period of January 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017.
