#### Dear Dr. Stacey Daniels-Young

I pray that you are doing well and once again thank you for everything you and COMBAT do to help sustain our recovery solution to the growing use and dependence of chemicals in our Jackson County communities. Stacey I'm reaching out to you on behalf of the Missouri Coalition of Recovery Support Providers and our Kansas City Substance Abuse Treatment and Recovery Support Coalition. Our two coalitions in partnership with DMH and SAMHSA, MCRSP will host our annual Northwest State Regional Conference for our recovery support providers in Kansas City, Missouri. The event will occur at the Blue Springs Marriot Hotel May 18, 19, 2017.

We would like to ask COMBAT to be a co-sponsor in the event and specifically assist with the Venue expense of the event. We respectfully ask for \$1,500.00 to help pay for the event venue at the Marriot Hotel in Blue Springs. We have a \$4,500.00 minimum cost requirement at the hotel for the two day conference. When we asked SAMHSA to consider sponsoring Phil as our featured speaker they quickly agreed to our request and let us know that SAMHSA was already in the process of sending Mr. Valentine to the state of lowa for a one week workshop in recovery communities. We also learned that our Department of Behavioral Health was sending our ATR Project Director, Mark Shields to participate in Phil's training in lowa. We believe that his visit to our Kansas City hosted regional conference is going to produce very beneficial results for our location providers as wells as those across the state.

Please let us know if COMBAT would consider helping us in this initiative for the Northwestern Region of our state.
