WHEREAS, Dean Suni is an active participant in statewide and local organizations and is known for speaking on issues that help practicing lawyers understand and use the law more effectively; and,

WHEREAS, Dean Suni is the recipient of many awards and recognitions, including her selection as a member of the inaugural class of Legal Leaders of Kansas City, the Missouri Lawyer's Media Women's Justice Award, the Outstanding Lawyer of the Year Award by the Association for Women Lawyers of Greater Kansas City, and the Spurgeon Smithson Award from the Missouri Bar Foundation; and,

WHEREAS, Dean Suni is a member of the Missouri Supreme Court Committee on the Future of the Legal Profession and co-chaired a conference related to Law Schools, Technology, and Access to Justice; and,

WHEREAS, students at the UMKC Law School and attorneys throughout Missouri hold Dean Suni in the highest regard and will miss her advice and contributions to the legal profession in Jackson County as dean; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature recognizes the extraordinary achievements of Dean Ellen Yankiver Suni, and extends its best wishes in all of her future endeavors.
