Four Food Service Management bids from Summit (formerly ABL); CBM; Aramark and Trinity were reviewed by Laura Scott, Brian Johnson and Craig Mosher. The lowest and best bid came from CBM, out of South Dakota. The references contacted, St. Louis City/County, the Wayne County Sheriff in Detroit Michigan, and the South Dakota State Penitentiary system all give CBM glowing recommendations and are very pleased with CBM's products and service.

CBM meets all of the bid requirements from Jackson County. They propose acceptable staffing levels. They work in numerous facilities that are accredited by the American Correctional Association. They also provide enclosed food carts that will more adequately retain heat. In addition they proposed the lowest cost per meal.

The Department of Corrections recommends that CBM be awarded the Food Service Management bid.

#### 7.0 QUOTATIONS

- 7.1 A meal is considered an inmate, staff, or visitor's meal. A sack meal or special diet, such as a medical or religion diet, is ordered for more than three meals a day. When a medical diet is ordered for more than three meals a day, such as six feedings a day or a PM snack, the most the Contractor can charge the County is the equivalent of three meals per day. Inmate worker snacks will provided at no cost.
- 7.2 Quotations for Annual Extensions: For the optional 4th and 5th annual extensions, the quotes will be negotiated at that time. The County reserves the right to reject any proposed, negotiated quotations for the 4th and 5th annual extensions. The County also reserves the right to re-bid for any reason.
