Four proposals for inmate phone services: from CenturyLink, GTL, NCIC, and Securus were evaluated by three Jackson County Department of Corrections associates: Laura Scott, Assistant Director of Administration; James Eickhoff, Manager of Detention Operations and Brian Johnson, Health & Behavioral Services Compliance Manager. Proposals were initially reviewed in three areas: 1) Scope of Services; 2) Experience and Personnel Qualifications; and 3) References. Upon completion of this review and evaluation, proposals were reviewed and evaluated regarding commission amounts offered by each vendor. All of the above categories were also reviewed with Praeses LLC consultants in order to make well informed decisions related to evaluation.

Scope of Services:

Summary scores under Scope of Services were highest for Securus at 36.07 points mainly due to an efficient implementation and installation history, additional technology at no cost and reliable video visitation equipment owned by Securus rather than a subcontractor. The remaining summary scores for Scope of Services were: CenturyLink – 35.55; GTL 30.91; and NCIC 28.53.

Experience and Personnel Qualifications:

Summary scores under this category were highest for CenturyLink at 9.67 mainly due to 24/7 access to a live operator for the public; excellent service for the public, inmates and the facility, only two lost contracts in the last 5 years, and the fact that they are a local company. The remaining summary scores for Experience and Personnel Qualifications were: GTL 8.0; NCIC 6.83 and Securus 8.67.

References:

Summary scores for References were highest for CenturyLink at 14 with the remaining scores at: 13 for GTL; 11.50 for NCIC and 13.50 for Securus. Communication with other correctional

facilities did confirm that references from Securus are very pleased related to service and video visitation.

Pricing:

Summary scores for pricing were highest for Securus at 33.25 due to the highest commission rate at 84.1%; an upfront supplemental payment of \$200,000; and an estimated annual revenue share of \$670,339. Securus also provides additional technology at no cost. Scores for the other three providers were: Century Link at 29.75; GTL at 27.42 and NCIC at 26.25.

Recommendation:

Total summary scores were highest for Securus and it is the recommendation of the Department of Corrections that Securus be awarded the Inmate Phone Services contract.
