SUBAWARD RECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH

JACKSON COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE

- 1. - 3. STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES: The Subrecipient acknowledges receipt and understanding of the HIDTA Program Policy and Budget Guidance produced by ONDCP as well as other guidelines that have been or will be approved by the Executive Board, and agrees to abide by them. The Subrecipient further agrees to comply with the terms of the Office of Management and Budget's "Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards", as well as all relevant state, county and municipal financial and accounting rules, regulations, standards and guidelines(www.whitehouse.gov).
