	Whereas, by Resolution 18045, dated December 3, 2013, the Legislature did authorize the First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the City for the furnishing of animal sheltering services at the Regional Animal Shelter.					
	Whereas by Ordinance 4505, dated February 11, 2013, the City has requested that the First Amendment approved the County be modified to specify that the City will retain ownership of the land, clarify County's responsibilities and require the establishment of an Animal Welfare Committee.					
	The First Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement specified a five year term, January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2017.
