REQUEST SUMMARY	Chapter 93, Jackson County Code, provides that each year not less than 50 percent of the proceeds of the COMBAT tax shall be appropriated for the arrest, prosecution, and incarceration of those accused of drug related offenses and /or violent crimes. Pursuant to the most recent non-binding resolution of intent regarding COMBAT allocations adopted by the Jackson County Legislature, the Jackson County Drug Task Force is recommended to receive, on an annual basis, a share equal to up to 9.5% of the projected COMBAT revenues. The Jackson County Drug Task Force recommends that the County Executive be authorized to execute an Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the Cities of Blue Springs, Buckner, Grain Valley, Grandview, Greenwood, Independence, Lake Lotawana, Lake Tapawingo, Lee's Summit, Lone Jack, Oak Grove, Raytown, Sugar Creek, and the Missouri State Highway patrol and the Jackson County Sheriff's Office. This Agreement will set out the right and responsibilities of each party participating in the Jackson County Drug Task Force, for a period to commence April 1, 2018, and continue for so long as the COMBAT tax is in effect.
