This mutually beneficial agreement has resulted in the addition of 2.2 miles of recreational trail constructed in the Blue River Parkway connecting it to the popular Indian Creek Trail system. The original agreement only covered Blue River Parkway property between Bannister Road and Red Bridge Road. Approval of Amendment #1 to the Agreement will expand the included area to the entire Blue River Parkway property. This additional area will allow further expansion of the trail system and to eventually connect to the Trolley Track Trail and other major trail connections. We are now requesting Amendment #1 be approved and the County Executive be authorized to sign it.
