REQUEST SUMMARY	We are requesting approval for the County Executive to execute a warranty deed transferring ownership of 0.817 acres of Blue River Parkway property to the City of Kansas City at the Kenneth Road Bridge over the Blue River. This parcel is to be used as Right Of Way for the new Kenneth Road bridge replacement. In exchange, Kansas City is deeding to Jackson County, 1.563 acres of City property adjacent to the park as replacement property. Documentation for this 6(f)3 property transaction was provided by the City and submitted to the Missouri Dept. Of Natural Resources and U.S. Dept. Of Interior for review. This transfer has been approved by both agencies. We request the County accept the deed for replacement property authorized by this conversion. Additionally, we are requesting approval for the County Executive to execute a Temporary Construction Easement of 3.7 acres of Blue River Parkway property along the north edge of Kenneth Road in conjunction with construction of the bridge.
