WHEREAS, the Medical Examiner's Office desires to enter into a month-to-month lease with Truman Medical Center (TMC) for the Medical Examiner's facility on TMC's Hospital Hill campus, at a cost of \$1.00 per year; and,

WHEREAS, this lease agreement is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached lease agreement; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments on the lease to the extent that sufficient appropriations are contained in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.

## LEASE

This Agreement is made as of,2019, between Truman Medical Center, Incorporated, a Missouri nonprofit corporation (the "Hospital") and Jackson County, Missouri, a body corporate and politic of the State of Missouri ("Lessee").
1. <u>Leasehold</u> . Hospital hereby leases to Lessee, and Lessee hereby leases from Hospital, the property located at 950 East 21st Street, Kansas City, Missouri, the current location of the County Medical Examiner (the "Premises").
2. Term. The Premises shall be leased from month to month beginning, 2019. Notwithstanding anything else in this Agreement to the contrary, either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other party of its intent to terminate the Agreement and setting forth the date of termination.
3. Option to Purchase. At any time during the term of this Lease, Lessee shall have the option to purchase the Premises for the payment of the sum of \$1.00. In the event of a purchase of the Premises pursuant to this paragraph, Hospital's obligations hereunder shall cease upon the closing of the purchase transaction. Further, Lessee's exercise of its option to purchase under this paragraph shall invalidate any pending lease termination notice issued by Hospital under paragraph 2 above.
4. Grounds and Systems Maintenance. As is provided in the current Agreement between the parties relating to the Medical Examiner's office, Hospital shall be responsible for maintenance of the exterior grounds of the Premises, to include, lawn mowing and watering, landscaping, tree trimming, snow removal, sidewalk and driveway repair, and the like. Hospital shall also be responsible for the maintenance and minor repair of the mechanical systems, to include plumbing and HVAC, within the Premises. Further, the Hospital shall continue to be responsible for the following services on the Premises:
<ul> <li>a. Hazardous waste disposal (including formalin disposal);</li> <li>b. Surgical towel laundering;</li> <li>c. Electricity bills; and</li> <li>d. Fire alarm monitoring.</li> </ul>
5. Rent shall be \$1 annually, payable on July 1.
6. <u>Insurance</u> . Hospital agrees to maintain at Hospital's expense comprehensive general liability and property/casualty insurance, comparable to that provided for all premises owned by the Hospital at the Hospital Hill location.

7. <u>Notice.</u> Any notices required to be given hereunder shall be given by certified U.S. mail, return receipt requested. If notice is given to the Lessee, it shall be addressed to:

- 8. Relationship of Parties. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed to create the relationship of principal and agent, partnership, joint venture, or of any association between Hospital and Lessee and no provision contained in this Agreement or any actions of the parties hereto shall be deemed to create any relationship between Hospital and Lessee other than the relationship of landlord and tenant.
- 9. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be governed, construed, and interpreted according to the laws of the State of Missouri.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Hospital and Lessee have caused this Agreement to be duly executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, on the day and year first written above.
