REQUEST SUMMARY	This easement request is from Jackson County residents David and Elaine Haake, who wish to access their home via an existing driveway. Their home lies just north east of the intersection of the Rock Island and Bannister Road above the Vale Tunnel. This is a unique case as the driveway has existed in this location for at least 65 years and the property owner cannot access their home any other way. The driveway does not conflict with the trail and will not conflict with any future transit project. Additionally, the landowner provided the survey and legal description for the easement at their own cost. For all of these reasons RIRCA recommends waiver of any applicable fees for this ingress/egress easement. Language in this agreement states that if the parcel is rezoned to any non-residential use the easement terminates and must be renegotiated.
