	Background: The Anti-Drug Sales Tax fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match and other anti-drug and anti-violence initiatives in the community.						
	The Jackson County Family Court Night Light Program is designed to address serious and potentially violent juvenile offenders who are either under pre-adjudication supervision, on probation, or re-entering the community from residential placement. The goals of the program are to hold youth accountable for their actions, reduce delinquent behavior, encourage sound social decision making behavior and reduce illegal substance abuse.						
	COMBAT funding of this program would provide critical afterhours monitoring conduct Probation Officers and a member of the Jackson County Sheriff's Department that suppoprogramming offered at the Family Court program. Without this funding, these high risk monitored for compliance to the court's requirements. This program has been shown to recidivism.
