REQUEST SUMMARY	Resolution requesting legislative approval of plaques being placed on the Andrew Jackson statues located at the downtown and Independence Courthouses. Proposed language is as follows: In 1826, the Missouri State Legislature named this county after the hero of the Battle of New Orled in the War of 1812 Andrew Jackson nearly three years before he became the nation's seventh President. Almost two centuries later, we hold a broader, more inclusive view of our nation. Jacks ownership of slaves and his support for the Indian Removal Act are part of his history. The act for Native Americans from their home territories so that white settlers could live there and triggered to Trail of Tears, a 1,000-mile march resulting in the death of thousands, including an estimated one quarter of the entire Cherokee nation.					
This statue of Jackson reminds us we are on a path that in the immortal words of Mart Jr. bends toward justice. In turn, we must acknowledge past injustices to help us create nation built upon humane policies to light our way and the way of humanity everywher
