REQUEST SUMMARY	Resolution 18600 authorized the County Executive to sign a cooperative agreement with Kansas City, Overland Park, and Lock Lloyd, for the replacement of Kenneth Bridge. The agreement allows the project to use up to \$3,000,000.00 from the off system bridge funds allocated to Jackson County. The other parties are contributing cash to fully fund the project. Kansas City has taken bids for the construction on the bridge, and is in the process of awarding the bid. Amendment 1 to the agreement, adjusts the funding to the actual costs based on the construction bid. The obligation of Jackson County remains the same as in the original agreement. Therefore, we request that the County Executive be authorized to execute amendment 1 to the cooperative agreement.
