REQUEST SUMMARY	This is a request to appropriate \$110,000 from the 2020 undesignated fund balance in acceptance of additional funds awarded to the Family Court Division by the Division of Youth Services to further support programs and services under the current grant named "Juvenile Court Diversion Program." The amendment to the program expands the scope to include the project called <i>Parenting with Love and Limits</i> which combines parent education and group therapy program with individual "coaching" (family therapy) sessions for adolescents and their parents. Ordinance 5270 was for the initial amount of \$292,967 and the additional amount is for \$110,000 for a total amount of \$402,967.00. The above referenced contract between 16th Judicial Circuit and the Department of Social Services is hereby amended as follows:

- The contract is amended for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
- This amendment adds \$110,000 for the Parenting with Love and Limits (PLL) demonstration project. 2.
- The County of Jackson Family Court Division shall devise an evaluation component that will track participating youth following completion of the program to determine if relapse and/or further penetration in the juvenile justice system was prevented.
- Reporting Requirements: 4.
- 4.1 The following reporting requirements are added per this amendment for PLL:
 - a) The contractor shall provide a bi-annual report providing the following information no later than 15 (fifteen) calendar days following the end of the each six (6) month period (January 15th).
 - 1. Number of families referred to the program that become actively engaged in the program.
 - 2. Completion rates of the program for families.
 - 3. Number of youth involved in the program that successfully complete probation.
 - 4. Six (6) month recidivism rates.
 - 5. Number of youth involved in the program that are committed to DYS compared to those diverted from commitment.
 - b) The contractor shall provide a year-end report showing the following information no later than July 15th following the end of the fiscal year.
 - 1. Number of families referred to the program that become actively engaged in the program.
 - Completion rates of the program for families.
 - 3. Number of youth involved in the program that successfully complete probation.
 - 4. Twelve (12) month recidivism rates.
 - 5. Number of youth involved in the program that are committed to DYS compared to those diverted from commitment.

This amendment shall be effective November 1, 2019. All other terms and conditions shall remain 5. unchanged.



**Program Name:** Parenting with Love and Limits (PLL)

Funding Agency: Missouri Division of Youth Services

Funding Arrangements and Use of Funds: \$110,000 to sustain the therapeutic model Parenting with Love and Limits parenting program within Field Services.

Funding Period for Grant: The grant period is July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020

New or Existing Program/Continued Funding Opportunity: Existing program through the Missouri Division of Youth Services.

**Program Description:** Jackson County Juvenile and Family Courts in partnership with DYS has a joint goal of increasing parent involvement to serve high risk dual diagnosed probation youth (ages I0-17) to both lower recidivism rates and prevent residential commitment through the integration of Parenting with Love and Limits (PLL).

Parenting With Love and Limits is a family therapy program for adolescents with the primary diagnosis of oppositional defiant or conduct disorder and their parents. The program consists of 8-10 family therapy sessions, which are conducted in the family's home. Additional sessions may be offered depending upon the needs of the youth and family. The program is designed to provide parents with tools and techniques to reestablish their ability to determine rules and restore nurturance to the parent-child relationship. The Family Court Clinical Program Manager provides oversight to this program. Additionally PLL provides clinical oversight through web conferencing to critique recorded sessions to insure fidelity and provide additional clinical supervision.

Theoretical or Practical Basis: Parenting with Love and Limits has been widely used in the United States, Canada, and the Netherlands. 31 sites in the United States and 7 sites in the Netherlands have been licensed to implement and practice the PLL model. PLL is an evidenced based program which is based upon a family systems approach.

Expected Impact: In a recent study, youth in the PLL group had significantly greater reductions in problem behaviors compared with youth in the control group. Specifically, they had greater reductions in anxiety and depression symptoms, social problems, attention problems, rule-breaking, aggressive behaviors, internalizing problems, and externalizing problems. Parents in the PLL group reported significantly greater readiness for change compared with parents in the control group. Parents in the in the PLL group also exhibited significantly improved communication with their teenage children and significant reductions in negative perceptions of their teenage children relative to the control group parents. Teens in the PLL group reported significantly greater levels of readiness to change and significantly improved communication with their parents, compared with teens in the control group. The total scores of parents in the PLL group differed significantly from those of parents in the control group, indicating improved attitudes and behaviors. Parents in the PLL group reported greater parental resilience, more social support, and better problem solving and communication relative to the control group.

Evaluation Plan and/or Demonstrated Efficacy: Parenting with Love and Limits is evaluated on an ongoing basis by the Court's Research and Development Department.
