The legislature has implemented this authority by the adoption of section 285 of the county code, which includes schedules that set out salary ranges for the county's non-merit associates. The full implementation of the Evergreen Associates salary study will require an amendment to section 285 and the adoption of a new salary schedule that reflects Evergreen's recommendations. | | |
